CHANGING HST TO 13% ON SHARP REGISTERS

THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ASSUME THAT THERE IS NO ERROR ON THE REGISTER, ALL SALES ARE COMPLETE, AND THE REGISTER IS NOT IN TRAINING.

NOTE : CA/AT IS "CASH" AND IS USUALLY THE BOTTOM RIGHT CORNER BUTTON (EXCEPT ON THE 550)

Run a tax report

FOR THE FOLLOWING MODELS ONLY:

550,570,610,470,460,440,450,420,410

1. Turn MA key to PGM2
 2. Type in: 2700 @/FOR CA/AT
- It should look like this:

Look for the tax that is set to 14% in the printout.

Whichever tax is set to 14% will be the number used below (#4 in the sample):

1. Turn MA key to PGM2

2. Type in: 2711 • @/FOR 4 @ 13 @ 1 CA/AT

Type in: 2700 @/FOR CA/AT

The final result should look like this:
